It came to our notice that a section of students residing in various Halls of Residence (including Zakir Husain Hall) have installed air conditioners (ACs) and/or high power consuming units/appliances in their rooms/flats without seeking any approval from the competent authorities. It is completely illegal to install ACs or other high power consuming appliances anywhere in the Institute without necessary approval from Refrigeration and Air conditioning unit and other competent authorities of IIT Kharagpur. Such illegal activity endangers safety of the residents in the halls because the electrical lines have not been designed for such heavy load.

It is hereby notified that students, who have installed ACs or similar electrical power hungry appliances illegally, must report in writing to HMC office latest by 5th March 2018, failing which a fine of Rs 10000 (Rupees ten thousand only) will be imposed on them. They must remove ACs and all such units from their rooms/flats latest by 7th March 2018 and carry out the necessary electrical and civil works redone at their own cost to bring the rooms/ flats back to same state as those were handed over/allotted to them. Strict action will be taken by the competent authority against any defaulter of this notice.
